Role Description

The Treasurer will have a diverse set of responsibilities that includes oversight of financial administration, strategic sparring partner for the board and director, control, and assurance of annual accounts. Together with other board members, the Treasurer will be responsible for the organization and management of the secretariat. 6 board meetings are held per year. The role also involves ensuring compliance with relevant laws, regulations and accounting standards.

The role as board member is voluntary and requires about 1 day of work per month.

- Providing strategic perspectives on the implementation of impact-weighted accounting and sustainable corporate governance
- Developing and implementing financial policies and procedures
- Managing and budgeting funds

- Ensuring compliance with relevant laws, regulations and accounting standards
